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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF M/S NATIONAL ALUMINIUM COMPANY LTD., FOR 3RD PHASE EXPANSION OF ALUMINA REFINERY (FROM 2.275 MTPA TO 3.275 MTPA) BY ADDITION OF 5TH STREAM ALUMINA REFINERY HAVING CAPACITY OF 1.0 MTPA AND EXPANSION OF STEAM CUM CO-GENERATION POWER PLANT (FROM 92.5 MW TO 111 MW) BY ADDITION OF 18.5MW CO-GENERATION POWER PLANT AT DAMANJODI, KORAPUT CD BLOCK, KORAPUT DISTRICT. HELD AT H.R.D CENTRE, NALCO AUDITORIUM, DAMANJODI DIST. KORAPUT ON 28.09.2016 AT: 11.00 A.M

Public hearing for the proposed 3rd phase expansion of Alumina Refinery (from 2.275 MTPA to 3.275 MTPA by addition of 5th stream Alumina Refinery having capacity of 1.0 MTPA and expansion of steam cum co-generation Power Plant (from 92.5 MW to 111 MW) by addition of 18.5 MW co-generation plant of M/s National Aluminum Company Limited was conducted on 28.09.2016 at 11 A.M as per the schedule programme at Damonjodi, Dist. Koraput. All the procedure for conducting the public hearing as per the EIA Notification, 2006 was followed. Prior to the public hearing advertisements through an Oriya Daily "Sambad" dated 27.08.2016 and an English Daily "The New Indian Express " dated 27.08.2016 regarding the venue, date and time of the public hearing along with the places of availability of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report, executive summary (Oriya & English) and soft copy in the office of the Collector, Koraput, District Industries Centre(DIC), Jeypore, Koraput, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Koraput, Head Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar, Regional Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada & Department of Forest & Environment, Govt. of Odisha and also in the website of State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org) was displayed for the general public. The same was also made available in the office of Block Development Officer, Semiliguda Panchayat Samiti, Semiliguda, Koraput District and Gram Panchayat office at Mathalput Gram Panchayat, Mathalput, Dist Koraput.

- Executive summery along with paper clippings regarding date, time, and venue of public hearing was made available to the nearby seven affected Gram Panchayat Offices.
- Further public announcements was made regarding Public Hearing for information of the public in the surrounding villages of the Plant.

Near about 1500 peoples gathered and participated in the hearing.

At the outset, Dr A.A.K Chatterjee, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public assembled in the hearing. He briefed about the EIA Notification, 2006 and the objectives of the public hearing and requested the public to give their views with respect to the expansion proposal made by M/s National Aluminum Company Limited (NALCO). He stated that M/s National Aluminum Company Ltd, has proposed to go for the 3rd phase expansion and has applied to obtain Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India. The Board has been entrusted to conduct the public hearing as it is a prerequisite for obtaining Environmental Clearance.

The Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada requested the audience to give their opinions orally, written or in both, based on the Environmental aspects. Then he requested the Additional District Magistrate, Koraput Shri Ekadashi Jena O.A.S (S) to kindly preside and supervise the public hearing.

The Additional District Magistrate welcomed the people for attending the hearing with a message to the audience that they should give their comments based on the Environment related aspects only. He briefed about the project and elaborated the objective of conducting public hearing in respect of any project seeking Environmental Clearance from the Govt. of India. Then he asked the representatives of M/s National Aluminum Company Ltd. to brief about the project.

Sri Prafulla Kumar Patra, DGM (E & S) of M/s NALCO, presented the salient features of the expansion project, the present status of the environmental conditions, possible impact on the environment due to such expansion activities and the remedial measures to be undertaken by the project proponent to reduce and mitigate the impact while executing the project, in Odia language. He concluded that a suitable Environmental Management Plan has been formulated and will be continuously upgraded to mitigate the impact on the different components of the environment such as Water, Air, Noise & Soil.

The Additional District Magistrate, Koraput invited the public to offer their views, objections, opinions, comments and suggestions regarding the project, specifically relating to environmental issues. A group of people immediately rushed to the stage and made agitation and give slogan against M/S NALCO and expressed their anguish about the noncompliance to the earlier demands. They also demanded to fulfill the assurances made to them,

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then only they will allow to conduct the public hearing. ADM has interfered and requested them to specifically put forth the issues before the chair and also give the opinion in the public hearing. The following speakers spoke and made their opinion.

1. Sri Dinabandhu Majhi:

He declined to tell his village name and expressed his dissatisfaction as M/s NALCO has not done any development work for the local people since last 35 years. NALCO has given employment to only one member of the family of the land losers and the other members (3 to 4 average) of a family are still remained unemployed and M/s NALCO is not doing anything for them. Though, the person has lost about 30 to 40 acres of their land for establishment of the industry in the beginning, but not yet obtain any benefit for them. The demand made by them during the last public hearing made in the year 2010, has also not yet been fulfilled by the industry. However he welcomed the project with a condition that the unit shall fulfill all the demands made by them.

2. Sri Dasarathi Mali, Gadipabuli

He welcomed the gathering and expressed his dissatisfaction as M/s NALCO has not done anything for the people. The land looser lost their land where they were cultivating the crops and not obtained suitable compensation for that. If they will compare the cost of the land now, then the people has lost everything and not obtained anything and their life became miserable. Till now near about 10,000 people remained unemployed and few people have got the employment as contractual labourer only. For the name of development M/s NALCO is doing amusement. People would have not opposed the proposal of expansion if NALCO could have solved the problem of the land displaced person earlier. Though the local people have completed the ITI course and other technical qualification, employment has not been given to them and in their place the unit is encouraging to give the employment to the outside people of Bihar, Jharkhand, Delhi, Chhatisgargh and Uttarpradesh. Further he pointed out that till date no facility has been provided by the industry for drinking water, toilets in Anlabadi Colony and Champapadr Colony, which shows the step motherly attitude of NALCO towards the people. No facility viz, road, water, hospital has been provided by the unit to the people. The Director of the CSR has not interacting with the local people and even not allowing them to speak. He demanded to constitute

a committee to look after the issues involving the local Sarpanch while formulating any proposal for CSR activity in the area. He also spoke that the people will welcome the expansion proposal if their demands shall be fulfilled.

3. Mrs Puspa Raju, Anlabadi Colony

She expressed her anguish for the attitude of M/s NALCO towards fulfillment of the demand as no remarkable development for the land displaced person has yet been done though, 35 years have already passed. M/s NALCO has set up a Hospital in the area, however, only the employees are getting benefit and the local people are deprived of getting the facility and they are told to go for treatment either at Koraput or Vizag. They are also not allowing the local people to take admission in the school made by M/s NALCO. People are fetching drinking water from 4 kms. distance and no facility has been given to them to get the drinking water. The company has given electric connection to the area, however the people are paying their electric bill. Similarly the widows of the land losers are facing a lot of problems and NALCO has not done anything for them. She conditionally supported the project and demanded that suitable employment to the local people as per their qualification and demanded that M/s NALCO authority should give the commitment with respect to all the demands made by her in writing.

4. Mrs Laxmi Mastiputa, Sarpanch. Mathalput.

Though M/s NALCO is a Navaratna company, it is needless to mention that no remarkable developmental work with respect to providing road, water, and employment has been done since last 35 years. She demanded that, proper benefit to the land looser shall be given and the CSR activities shall be done through Sarpanch. She also told that if M/s NALCO will fulfill the demand made by the people since last 35 years, then she will welcome the expansion proposal.

After this most of the people agreed to the points raised by the above speakers and told that they do not have anything more to speak. The people demanded to invite the project proponent to give the reply immediately. The speakers declined to sign in the attendance sheet (**Copy Enclosed as Annexure-I**). 25 nos.(Twenty Five) of representation /views of the public has been received during the hearing and the same are enclosed herewith (55 pages).

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Regional Officer has summarized the views given by the speakers and ADM has requested the Project proponent to redress the issues raised by the speakers in the public hearing.

Sri Rajkishor Mishra, Executive Director, M/s NALCO redressed the issues made by the speakers which is enclosed and **Annexure-II (in English) and Annexure-III (in Odia)**.

About 1500 people attended the public hearing. Signed copy of 23 people is enclosed here with as **Annexure- IV**. The other people denied to put their signature and snatched away some signed copy and insisted other people for not to sign in the attendance sheet.

At last Regional Officer has proposed the vote of the thanks to the chair and public and ADM, Koraput declared the closure of the public hearing.

1	Rehabilitation of affected people	Since inception in 1981, M/s NALCO has been committed for the welfare of peripheral villagers though there was no such guidelines from the Government during those days. However State Government, Central Government & Nalco had come up with a Comprehensive Rehabilitation & Resettlement (R&R) package comprising of compensation, employment & other benefits for the affected people of Nalco project. Nalco will continue to work on this front in future & cares will be taken for resolving the issues of LDPs, as permissible within the framework of company guidelines.
2	Employment	M/s NALCO has given employment to 600 land displaced persons who were displaced during its inception in 1981. As Nalco is a government of India enterprise, it has to follow all the rules & regulations of the Government for providing employment to locals. M/s NALCO is in the process of recruiting 27 nos. through direct employment & another 57 nos. are proposed for recruitment soon. Besides the above, it was clarified that 462 persons are to be employed under the proposed 5 th stream expansion.
3	Health	M/s NALCO foundation has provided 04 nos. Mobile Health Units (MHU), which have been working in the peripheral villages to cater the medical needs of the people. The MHUs are covering 142 villages & 21 hamlets of the periphery area for health check-up and distributing free medicines to the needy in the remote areas. About 70,000 people are being treated by the

		MHUs per annum in the peripheral villages. Apart from this Nalco is going to set up an OPD (Out Patient Department) in the near future, for catering to the need of local people.
4	Education	M/s NALCO has set up two schools in its township. One is Saraswati Vidya Mandir (SVM) & other is Delhi Public School (DPS). Out of total student strength, about 70% students are from peripheral villages in SVM and around 20% are in DPS. Besides, Nalco has taken a noble initiative by sponsoring 655 students from the periphery villages to the schools of Bhubaneswar, Koraput & Jeypore. Further, Nalco has decided to sponsor 100 more students from periphery villages to study in Bhubaneswar, Koraput & Jeypore in near future.
5	Drinking water facility	It was clarified that further improvements for providing safe drinking water to the 2 LDP colonies i.e. Shahid Laxman Nayak Nagar & Ambedkar Nagar are being initiated. In addition to the provision of supply of water through pipeline, bore wells have also been installed in LDP colonies to meet the requirement of the people.
6	Rehabilitation of widows	M/s NALCO management is very much concerned for this issue. It is clarified that a committee has been formed consisting of Nalco senior officers (02 Deputy General Managers) as members, to look after the issues and suggest all possible remedial measures which can be considered for implementation, within the guidelines.
7	Peripheral Development	For this proposed expansion, about 100 Crore Rs. has been earmarked towards CSR & peripheral development activities. Various activities will be undertaken under CSR scheme for development of periphery villages.
