PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S UTKAL ALUMINA INTERNATIONAL LTD. DORAGUDA, TIKIRI, RAYAGADA FOR ENHANCEMENT OF PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF ALUMINA REFINERY FROM 1.5 MTPA TO 3.0 MTPA ALONG WITH CO- GENERATION POWER PLANT CAPACITY FROM 90 MW TO 150 MW AT DORAGUDA, TIKIRI IN THE DISTRICT OF RAYAGADA HELD ON 15.11.2017 AT 10.00 A.M AT BAGHRIJHOLA, HADIGUDA GRAMPANCHAYAT, TAHSIL KASHIPUR, DIST RAYAGADA

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 15.11.2017 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Local Dailies. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Madhusudan Mishra, OAS(S) Project Director, DRDA, Rayagada presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Er Rabinarayan Mishra, AVP (SH&E) of M/s Utkal Alumina International Ltd, Doraguda, Tikiri Rayagada has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

1. Sri Shankar Prasad Muduli, Baghrijhola

Sri Muduli introduced himself as a law student and questioned on the development and benefits availed by the local public due to the existing project. He expressed concern over the continuing Dadan Labour problem in the area due to lack of employment in the project. He informed that in spite of losing 15 Ac. of Land for the existing project he has not get any job. He opined that the land provides lively hood from generation to generation but employment can't. He emphasized on the direct interaction with the land losers by the company for getting benefit. He demanded for a 500 bedded Hostel at Kucheipadar and Hadiguda and an ITI at Baghrijhola for proper training of local youth. He supported the project with a condition that their demands to be full filled first.

2. Sri Bhubani Gauda, Lachuguda

Sri Gauda expressed that there was no road to Hadiguda Grampanchayat and also no bus facilities for the students going to the company school. He also informed that many domestic animal including human beings lost their life in Red Mud Pond and Ash Pond. He told that though they are facing pollution problem due to the project but not getting any employment. He expressed his dissatisfactions over the employment of the outsiders in the project ignoring the locals. He urged that the company should provide employment first and then go for expansion.

3. Sri Shankar Naik, Paikupakhal

Sri Naik emphasized on employment of the local educated youth, development of roads, proper justice to land losers and contract work to the locals and reengagement of their vehicle on hired basis for financial benefits of the locality. He welcomed the project.

4. **Sri Ram Shankar Naik, Kendukhunti**

Sri Naik expressed his dissatisfaction over the so called development in Kashipur & Hadiguda Gram Panchayat and pointed out that only 5% development has been achieved. Being a Diploma Holder, He stressed on proper employment of local Technical youth in the project. He demanded for drinking water provisions in villages of Hadiguda Panchyat and appointments of teachers in model schools, repair of schools for development of education. He welcomed the project hoping that Hadiguda Panchayat youth will get employment.

5. **Sri Sanjib Mandangi, D-Korol**

He demanded for permanent employment of D Korol village people in the project to reduce their difficulties.

6. **Sri Umashankar Majhi, Kucheipadar**

Sri Majhi expressed that though company made development but it is not complete. Further he suggested that company should complete the remaining construction work of the local dam and restart the training of local youths. He emphasised on 80 to 90 % employment of the local people on priority basis instead of outsiders in the project.

7. **Sri Bidyadhar Dhuria, Tikiri**

Sri Dhuria urged that Pollution Control Board should look into the Pollution problem of the locality. He pointed out the condition of surrounding bare Hills due to lack of proper Plantation, poor health facilities in spite of company started its operation and bad road conditions. He emphasized on development of education in Kashipur and Tikiri with a demand for provision of College at Tikiri for higher education of local students & job opportunity for ITI students. Further he expressed his displeasure on the poor employment of local educated youth & appointment of outsiders in the project. He urged that at least 70% local educated mass should get direct employment in the plant & demanded for overall development of Kashipur block by the plant.

8. **Sri Chandramani Bagh, Paikupakhal**

He told that they have benefitted by the plant & hope that it will continue. He stressed on the employment of remaining land losers. He supported the project.

9. **Sri Sabala Naik, D-Korol**

He relied on Government for the establishment of the project and hope for more benefits by the project.

10. **Sri Kartika Naik, Kucheipadar**

He compared the benefits extended by other companies like Jindal, Posco etc in other areas and demanded for the similar package for them. He offered his land to the company at a better price and also demanded for permanent employment in the plant for him.

11. **Sri Edison Naik, Paikupakhal**

He demanded for permanent employment for communicators who have contributed for establishment of the company.

12. **Sri Sanjib Kumar Bagh, Badlijharan**

He expressed his concern over the pollution of Bada Nadi water due to discharge from the plant affecting the domestic animals, causing skin problem of the public in 13 villages in downstream of the plant. He welcomed the plant with a demand of supplying proper drinking water facilities to the affected villages.

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13. Sri Haladhar Naik, D-Korol

He emphasised on identification of land losers and provision of Identity Card for them by the company for their benefit and demanded permanent job for land losers and ITI students. Further he demanded for drinking water facilities to Kasipur block people through overhead Tanks. He stressed on permanent employment for local people instead of outsiders. He welcomed the project and urged for Displacement of village D Korol (Upper Sahi).

14. Sri Phakir Majhi, Bhitaramuchukuni

Sri Majhi showed his displeasure for ignorance by the company to the land losers and hope that company will cooperate for development of Kashipur block. Also he demanded for training and employment of ITI holders. He strongly opposed the engagement of outsiders ignoring the land losers in the plant.

15. Sri Bhagban Majhi, Kucheipadar

Sri Majhi questioned about the commitment made by the company to improve the status of Kashipur block to a world class level. He informed that about 2000 peoples from 24 nos. of village get displaced by handing over their 2868 Ac land to the company but no permanent employment. He demanded for permanent employment to the land losers as skilled labour category from generation to generation. He expressed his concern over the Dadan labour problem in Kashipur as well as in whole Rayagada District. He questioned about the eradication of diseases like Diarrhea, Malaria and other health problems from the nearby area. He suggested for publication of development map for Kashipur area by the State/Central government to get aware about the development for their future generation. He demanded for a declaration of beneficial packages by the government prior to proceed for expansion of the project. He also demanded for the conversions of UP schools of all villages as model schools by the company for further development of the education.

16. Sri Josheph Bhadra, D- Korol

Sri Bhadra demanded for issue of Identity Cards for the land owners who have given their land for the company. He appealed to the company to extend their support for converting all Government schools as model schools. He further demanded for establishment of a technical institution in the locality and to provide job for the local youth on priority basis. He suggested to provide Dhandamulaka Sikhya to the uneducated people for their lively hood. He demanded for free treatment of land losers at Tikiri Hospital, urged for support from the company for development of Health facilities for ladies and provision of 10 nos. of Ambulance facilities in the local area by the company. He supported the expansion project with a condition that their demand should be full filled prior to proceed. He expressed his concerned over the dust pollution problem in the adjacent villages due to the plant and suggested for their displacement. He advised for massive plantation in surrounding areas to control dust pollution.

17. Smt. Kunti Naik D- Korol

She introduced her as land loser and expressed that she was behind the Bar in spite of giving land to the company. She demanded for DP status of village D- Korol. She requested to provide job facilities for the ladies.

18. Sri Sarbodhan Takiri, D- Korol

Sri Takiri drew attention on local unemployment and education problem. He informed that Upper sahi of D- Korol village has not yet been displaced though 21 years have been lapsed. He supported the project based on provisions of three basic needs i.e food, cloth and shelter by the company.

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19. **Sri Bhabagrahi Naik, Kashipur**

He suggested for massive plantation in each Panchayat through financial support by the company under peripheral development programme. He further suggested to supply drinking water to all villages suffering from water scarcity under Kashipur block by the company. He suggested for establishment of +2 Science College at Tikiri, +3 Science Collage at Kashipur and to take over the Kashipur ITI and provision of training for economical development of the ladies through tailoring etc and provision of 2 nos. of student bus from Dongasil to Kashipur by the company.

20. **Sri Sudharm Naik, Paikupakhal**

Being an ITI holder and being land loser Sri Naik strongly demanded for the job in the plant, also opposed the employment of outsiders and demanded for DP status.

21. **Sri Lakidhar Naik, Paikupakhal**

Sri Naik informed that though he is an ITI holder but company offers him job on contractual basis and he demanded for permanent job in the plant.

22. **Sri Lakhi Naik, Tikarpada**

Sri Naik told that though he is land loser but not get any employment in the plant. He expressed his concern over the pollution due to Red Mud Pond and Ash Pond affecting the people and domestic animals in 24 surrounding villages. He has shown some X Ray copies of his broken bones regarding his orthopaedic problems and seeks daily wages from the company since he is a land loser.

23. **Smt. Champa Muduli, Baghrijhola**

She expressed that the plant has not fulfilled their commitments made earlier regarding development of the area. Further she complains they are not getting proper health care facilities at the hospital. She told that they will not allow the company to expand until their demands get fulfilled. She expressed her dissatisfaction on the company for not providing facilities to them.

24. **Smt Rambhamani Sahu , Baghrijholla**

She showed her aggression against the company for not providing ant benefit and job to her son and she demanded that job should given to the local youth otherwise they will not support the project.

25. **Sri Stephan Bagh, Paikupakhal**

Sri Bagh expressed that they are given their land for employment instead company asking them to do Dairy farm and poultry farm. He demanded for the construction of road from Doraguda to Baphlimali which company has committed earlier. He also demanded for the gate pass to the land losers.

26. **Smt Lukei Majhi , Rameda**

She told that they are not getting any benefit even after losing 8Ac of land for the existing plant. She demanded for DP status and other benefits from the project.

27. **Smt Alai Majhi, R R Colony**

She demanded for salary of Rs 50,000/- or else they will not allow the project to come up.

28. **Smt Sambhari Majhi, R R Colony**

She told that company has not given anything to her and questioned that how she will survive.

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
29. Sri Jayadev Naik, Kodipari


Sri Naik questioned the district administration that why this public hearing is being conducted and Sri Madhusudan Mishra, Chairman of the hearing clarified on the objectives and procedures followed for the hearing. Then he seeks information from the company regarding the development made by them in their locality till date. In responding to the quarry Sri SK Mishra , Chairman and Sri Siba Shankar Mohapatra, DGM (CSR) of M/s UAIL, Doraguda, Tikiri presented the statistical data of the different peripheral activities carried by them before the public.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Sri SK Mishra, Chairman of the M/s UAIL responded to the issues raised.





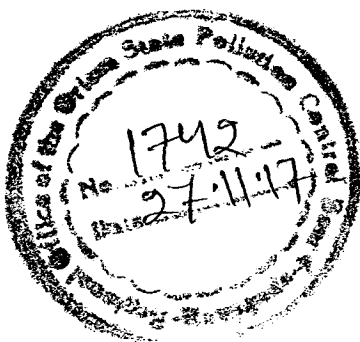

<p>1. Barrier around Red Mud Pond & Ash Pond for protection of human & animals.</p>	<p>Red mud pond area is protected by boundary wall and fence. Ash pond is situated on a hill top valley and surrounded by deep garland drains and guard wall, and thus is protected. The guard wall is being strengthened. It is worth mentioning here that, we have recently commissioned the Red Mud Filtration Unit, which will filter the wet Red Mud from 55% solids to 75% solids, thereby eliminating wet disposal. Now, Red Mud is disposed in dry form, hence hazards for humans and animals due to wet disposal have been completely eliminated.</p> <p>Both these ponds are under continuous security surveillance. Operation and maintenance personnel are continuously monitoring the pond status. In future expansion also similar actions will be continued.</p>
<p>2. Prevention of Dust pollution caused by the industry in Dwimundi, D Korol & other nearby villages</p>	<p>All the mitigation measures stated in the EIA, EMP have been implemented effectively to protect the environment. These measures are the part of the plant design and have been implemented since the day one of operation of the plant.</p> <p>The Air Pollution Control measures that have already been implemented to mitigate dust pollution are installation of state of the art equipment like ESP, Bag Filters, DSS, DES and Wet Scrubbers etc. at respective point source or fugitive source.</p> <p>In addition to the above High pressure fixed water sprinkling system put in place at Bauxite & Coal handling area to control fugitive dust emission. Regular water sprinkling and cleaning is being carried out on roads through mobile water tanker to reduce fugitive emission. All in plant roads have been black-topped/concreted.</p> <p>Moreover, plantation along the boundary wall is being carried out to prevent the dust pollution in Dwimundi, D. Korol and other nearby villages. In proposed expansion similar air pollution control measures will be adhered to, from the design stage.</p>

River water Pollution in Bada Nadi due to discharge from plant affecting downstream villages.</p>	<p>The plant is operating on a zero liquid discharge principle as mandated by the OSPCB & MoEFCC. Various ponds like Red Mud Pond, Ash Pond, Caustic Pond, Guard Pond and Holding Pond are in place to collect and reuse waste water in the process. STP (Sewage treatment Plant) has been provided to treat the domestic waste water and reuse of treated water in gardening and afforestation. The expanded plant will have similar features to prevent any waste water discharge to outside and the plant will be designed and operated on Zero Discharge concept.</p>
<p>4. Plantation over surrounding bare hills.</p>	<p>Plantation is a continuous activity at Utkal. We have developed in-house Nursery spreading over an area of five acres having capacity of 2.0 lakh saplings at Plant site and another nursery at Baphlimali Bauxite Mines of capacity 0.5 lakh saplings. These saplings are being planted for greenbelt development in and around the plant premises & Bauxite mines. Plantation has been carried out on bare hills and other areas owned by Utkal Alumina. UAIL will explore possibility of plantation in the surrounding private land and bare hills in coming years in consultation with the concerned land-owners and the Govt.</p>
