

PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION / HEARING ON REVISED MASTER PLAN DEVELOPMENT OF M/S DHAMRA PORT COMPANY LTD. HELD ON 11.04.2018 (11 AM) AT KANAK PRASAD VILLAGE (D.R.D.O. HELIPAD) UNDER TAHASIL – CHANDBALI IN THE DIST. OF BHADRAK

- Sri Gyana Das, Collector & Dist. Magistrate of Bhadrak district presided over the meeting.
- Dr. P. K. Mohapatra, Regional Officer, Balasore of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present for the public hearing and explained them on different aspects of the public hearing for the environmental clearance of the project on the Revised Master Plan Development ^{of Dhamra Port} as per provisions of the E. I. A. Notification, 2006 framed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986. Dr. Mohapatra then invited the project proponent or his / her representative or consultant to present details of the project, its environmental aspects and proposed pollution control measures / systems before the public to make them aware on the matter before they opine their views.
- Sri B. K. Swain, Advisor (Environment), representative of M/s Dhamra Port Company Ltd. presented the project and told that this is an old port since 1881 which was reconstituted in 1998 and started in 2011. M/s Dhamra Port Company Ltd. started its operation since 2014 @ 25 million tonnes of cargo handling per annum with 2 nos. of berths. The port has already gone for 1st expansion in Phase II with the capacity of 96.8 million tonnes of cargo handling and containerised cargo of 1 million TEUs. The port has now proposed for revised master plan development for 5 years and 30 years enhancing capacities respectively to 110 and 314 million tonnes of cargo handling per annum. Sri Swain briefed about company activities on dust removal, maintenance of cleanliness, installation and operation of ETP/STP, green belt development, storm water drainage and compliance of CPCB/SPCB guidelines. 50 to 60 years. He also highlighted on company objectives on peripheral development and CSR activities.
- The President, Sri Das, Collector then invited the public present in the meeting to register their names and present their views.

- Out of about 800 nos. of persons present in the meeting, 29 nos. of persons only registered to opine their views; attendance sheet with signature of 28 nos. of persons is enclosed in the annexure and views of 23 nos. of persons on the project are mentioned below.

1. Sri Ugrasen Madhual, Chhadag Bansada village:

Sri Madhual told for development of green belt on environmental aspect. He however told that local leaders have recently conducted a meeting welcoming the expansion project for benefit of all. He also expressed that loss of income from sea fishing by local poor villagers shall be considered by Dist. Administration and Port Authority.

2. Sri Bana Bihari Maity, Kaitha Khola village:

Sri Maity told on forestation against deforestation activity on environmental aspect. He referred that the public hearing for the second expansion programme is being held at Kanak Prasad village and Dist. Administration and Port Authority shall consider loss of income from sea fishing by local poor villagers.

3. Sri Balabhadra Lenka, Jagula village:

Sri Lenka told on loss of green area due to development of the port, dust pollution due to spread of coal dusts, deposit of dust layer on village ponds and drainage of storm water to sea relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on rehabilitation activities and constitution of local committees to find out permanent solution of local problems.

4. Sri Amiya Mohapatra, Kaitha Khola village:

Sri Mohapatra told on peripheral problem on spread of coal dust and non development of green belt to control dust spreading relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on peripheral development on medical facility, supply of drinking water, engagement of local poor villagers, village road development etc.

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5. Sri Ashok Kumar Jena, Bidyutprava village:

Sri Jena told only on peripheral development relating rehabilitation, employment opportunity, construction of over-bridge near old G.P. office, development of fish drying area, safe movement of fishing trawlers, providing deep tube well, cremation palace, veterinary hospital, engineering school/college, meeting place in Dosinga High School etc.

6. Mr. S. K. Malikuddin, Kanak Prasad village:

Mr. Malikuddin welcomed the expansion project on behalf of the village and G.P. and told only on social and education development matters.

7. Sri Jayanta Behura, Guansol village:

Sri Behura only told to constitute a committee of all parties to sort out the misunderstandings and set a healthy environment.

8. Mr. Mujibar Ali Khan, Sabitrisarasi (Dosinga) village:

Mr. Khan told on pollution due to spread of coal dusts and deposit of these on village ponds relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on peripheral development relating educational facility, providing deep tube well, shifting road side wine shops, problem on movement of coal trucks etc.

9. Sri Ashok Kumar Pandit, Balisahi village:

Sri Pandit only told on employment of land losers, loss of income from sea fishing, providing equipments in schools etc.

10. Sri Pradeep Behera, Laxmiprasad village:

Sri Behera told only on permanent solution of rehabilitation problem, protection of income from sea fishing etc.

11. Sri Maniklal Dinda, Jyostnamayee village:

Sri Dinda told on coal dust pollution and development and maintenance of green belt relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on

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rehabilitation of skilled and unskilled ones, peripheral development on black topping roads, providing deep bore well, shukhua or fish drying area etc.

Two nos. of women from local villages intervened without registration and told on their personal and local problems where the Collector assured to listen personally towards this month end.

12. Sri Digambar Das, Bansada village:

Sri Das told on coal dust pollution relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on rehabilitation matter of the project and supported the expansion project.

13. Mr. S. K. Bakar Alli, Kanak Prasad village:

Mr. Alli told on survival of plantations claimed to be done relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on rehabilitation matters and peripheral development related matters the Collector then assured to listen to their rehabilitation matters in his office later and requested them to continue the hearing.

14. Sri Pramod Kumar Nayak, Jagula village:

Sri Nayak told on coal dust pollution and non covering of coal carrying trucks relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on medical facility, educational development, aid to govt. & non govt. schools, supply of drinking water, development of Maa Dhamrai Temple, road communication to Chandbali, employment opportunity, skill development centre, police station, souchalaya at bus stand, street lights, wine shop, stadium etc.

15. Sri Debendra Nayak, Dosinga village:

Sri Nayak told on road side plantations relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on accusation and arrest of villagers wrongly out of last 15th August issue.



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6. Sri Trilochan Pradhan, Jagula village:

Sri Pradhan personally supported the project only

17. Sri Chandrasekhar Jena, Jagula village (B.M.S.):

Sri Jena only told on area development due to the project and supported it.

18. Mrs. Khata Biwi, Balisahi village:

Mrs. Khata Told One earlier woman intervned and told to excuse her earlier expression and expressed on local problems like no school in Balisahi village.

19. Sri Ranjan Sahoo, Guahala village:

Sri Sahoo told only on water problem in the 8 nos. of local G.P.s and providing proper medical treatment facility.

20. Sri Ramesh Chandra Nayak, Dhankota village:

Sri Nayak told on sound pollution caused due to vehicular horns relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on peripheral development matters on educational facility, socio-economic improvement, road widening, speed reduction of transport vehicles etc.

21. Sri Kiran Kumar Behera, Bhubaneswar (OMF):

Sri Behera told on peripheral development matters like dependant villagers on sea fishing, poor house conditions, rehabilitation etc. When peripheral development from 2011-18 with rupees 8 crores per annum has not been appreciative, 15 crores per annum in future is doubtful for further development.

22. Sri Surendra Jena, Dosinga village:

Sri Jena told on village pond water problem for drinking due to spread of coal dusts relating environmental aspect of the area. He also told on peripheral development matters on development of fish drying area, employment of fishermen etc.

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23. Mr. Abdul Rehman, Bidyutprava village:

Mr. Rehman did not tell on any environmental matter.

Sri Byomakesh Ray, Hon'ble M.L.A, Chand^dali then addressed on the area development and supported the project. He also told on different peripheral development matters of the area and assured the public on the conditional support to fulfil the commitments by the port authority.

No other people present in the public hearing delivered his/her views. The President and Collector, Sri Das then read over the summary of the proceedings reflecting the views and concerns expressed by all the persons in local / vernacular language and asked the project proponent or his/her representative (s) to explain the public on the following issues raised by them.

- CSR and peripheral development activities like local potable water problem, review of implementation of commitments done in earlier public hearing, restoration of livelihood of fishermen, revival of local coordination committee, rehabilitation of earlier land losers on employment, educational development, road infrastructure, development of fish drying area, Dhamra river dredging, removal of shore silts from Dhamra river, shifting local wine shops, development of tourism centre near Dhamrai temple etc.
- Pollution control and environmental activities like green development and plantation of 10 lakhs sapling, protection of bani jungle (mangrove trees), drainage of storm water, control of spreading of coal dust to nearby localities and pond water pollution thereof, cleaning of creeks, road water sprinkling, FSRU facility etc.

Sri Subrat Tripathy, Chief Executive Officer of M/s Dhamra Port Company Ltd. explained the above issues raised by the public as below.

- Reconstitution of local coordination committee, help on need assessment, distribution of scholarships to meritorious students at 10+ level, establishment of DAV Public School, development of 5 acres of earmarked govt. land for shukhua khola (fish drying area), harbour dredging, road development, earmark of port

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
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channel for safe movement of fishing trawlers, development of skill centre by September/October and employment in ports of Adani group etc.

- Adoption of all provisions of respective environmental rules & regulations, non deviation of rules & regulations in the past, development of green belt, plantation of 10 lakh saplings in gramya jungle area, development of green belt in 5 years over 129 hectares and in 30 years over 260 hectares, installation of dust screen beside coal stack area and water sprinkling to prevent dust spreading and control fugitive dust emission, FSRU facility under planning for handling of LNG etc.


