

PROCEEDING OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 27.11.2018 AT SUNIAPADA FOOTBALL FIELD, BISWALI IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF M/s. KAPILAS CEMENT MANUFACTURING WORKS (A UNIT OF M/s. OCL INDIA LIMITED) FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW CEMENT MILL OF CAPACITY 2.5 MILLION TONNES PER ANNUM TO EXPAND THE EXISTING CEMENT GRINDING CAPACITY FROM 1.70 MILLION TONNES PER ANNUM TO 4.20 MILLION TONNES PER ANNUM IN VILLAGE BISWALI, PO: BARUNIA IN CUTTACK DISTRICT, ODISHA

The public hearing in respect of environment impact assessment of M/s. Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works (a unit of M/s. OCL India Limited) for establishment of a new cement mill of capacity 2.5 million tonnes per annum to expand the existing cement grinding capacity from 1.70 million tonnes per annum to 4.20 million tonnes per annum in village Biswali, Po: Barunia in Cuttack district of Odisha was held on 27th November, 2018 at 10:00am at Suniapada Football field, Biswali with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

The Panel consists of the following members:

1. Sri Harish Chandra Nayak, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack
2. Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack

At the outset, Sri Harish Chandra Nayak, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack welcoming the public participating in the public hearing meeting and gave a brief introduction of the proposed project of M/s. Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works and asked the public to participate whole heartedly and complete the hearing peacefully.

Then Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer the representatives of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works (a unit of M/s. OCL India Limited). Welcoming the public, Dr. Giri, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack, explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Sri Manoranjan Sahoo, Deputy Executive Director & Unit Head, M/s. Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works addressed the committee members and assembled public in Odia and told briefly about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various CSR activities of the existing unit and the proposed project.

Then Sri Harish Chandra Nayak, Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack requested the public to give their views and opinions about the proposed project and informed that all the proceeding of the meeting will be recorded video graphically and also written statement and submitted to the government and finally invited the public to give their views on the proposed project.

The following speakers have given their views on the above said project, which are as follows:

1. Sri Chitaranjan Samal, Advocate, Uchhapada, Cuttack:

He welcomed the gathering and extended his full support for the proposed project. He expressed that by year 2000 Odisha Textile Mill was closed and by 2004 Odisha Cotton Mill was closed and industrialization came to a halt in this area. At that time OCL came forward to establish a cement industry in this area. In the Initial phase people have perception that the cement industry would make pollution and the plants and trees would be covered by cement dust in a radius of 10 km. But when the industry was established the reality was different. It is observed that there is no such type of pollution as the executives of the company are residing in a distance of 50 mtr from the factory in the colony. OCL is the least polluting industry in this area. OCL has done extensive work in the area starting from plantation, support to house fire & distress victims before the govt. support arrives. After establishment of OCL 90% of the local youth got direct employment and other indirect employment through transportation work (about 20 nos.) and by other means about 4000-5000 peoples are engaged. Again there was a misconception about drawing of ground water for industrial use. But practically it is observed that whatever rainwater conserved by OCL, has met the annual requirement of the industry and only ground water is used for domestic use. OCL organized 'Prativa Samman' to encourage and support the poor meritorious students of this area including financial support. Regarding drinking water OCL has installed drinking water project in Kanheipur GP by spending Rs. 15 lacs along with government facility. After establishment of OCL it provides free medicine to the older persons in this area. Lastly he requested OCL management that whatever employment opportunities will be created in the proposed project, at least 90% of employment from the local community is to be considered and there will be development in their area and the local unemployed people will be economically developed.

2. Sri Subodha Kumar Samal, Sarapanch , Garudagaon GP:

He welcomed the gathering and supported the proposed expansion of the proposed project. OCL has always extended their support for the development of the periphery area in all aspects like employment, peripheral development, health, environment, education and other work which is commendable. He requested to the management for giving employment and to give priority to Garudagaon GP in developmental work and employment to locals.

3. Sri Biraja Prasad Rout, Sarapanch, Uchhapada GP:

He first thanked all for gathering here for Public Hearing. He addressed all the chairpersons and M/s. OCL representatives. He expressed that OCL has done various developmental works for the local people on various aspects like deepening of pond, education, health and sanitation. He requested OCL to give priority to the local people on employment for the proposed expansion. He expressed that OCL should do its expansion so that the periphery area will also be economically developed and finally favored the project.

4. Sri Biswanath Swain, Senior Citizen, Kanheipur GP:

He welcomed the proposed project. He expressed that OCL was established in this area and thanked them for helping them in developing their area economically. He favoured their

expansion project and gave his consent for expansion and for the people of their GP. He informed that when two nos. of industries like OCM (Odisha Cotton Mill) & Dhanmandal Jute Mill were sick and defunct. OCL has done various types of social developmental work on various areas and also requested the management for continuing such type of developmental work after expansion. He requested the company management to provide training in tailoring and other aspects for the unemployed youths of different nearby panchayat. They have also helped in stopping open defecation and built toilet in Biswali village and also for school development. They have provided mobile health care facility and given treatment and medicine to old person, desilted and renovated their ponds. He requested OCL to do large scale Bamboo Plantation for use as a green fuel, help to SHGs, girls who are unemployed and give schemes and provide financial help, extension of Mobile Medicare Services to the tribal hamlets with solar light provisions, check dam construction for rainwater harvesting to use in farming of the local farmers and provision of employment to the local people as per their education qualification so that the economic condition of the area will develop. Also he requested for construction of Truck terminal at Nimeishapur and regular water sprinkling on approach and village roads for dust suppression as well as providing drainage facility along the roads.

5. Sri Rajesh Kumar Sarangi, PS Member, Kanheipur:

He welcomed all the gatherings and thanked the OCL management for their financial support to Kanheipur GP for various developmental work done in the GPs and also funded a project of Rs. 16 lakhs at Kanheipur. He requested the management to provide employment to the unemployed youths of Kanheipur GP and supported the proposed project.

6. Sri Partha Kumar Sarangi, PS Member, Safa:

He addressed the chairpersons and the public present. He mentioned that the local youths should be given more priority for employment. OCL should more focus on developmental activities of Safa & Karajni GP as these areas are mostly dominated by tribals and welcomed the project.

7. Sri Harmohan Pradhan, Sapanpur:

He introduced himself and addressed the Chairpersons and the gatherings. He thanked the OCL management as they have taken Safa & Kotsahi GP in their periphery GPs., but they should continue to have good relation between the industry and the people. M/s. OCL has done various developmental work in the local area and helped them all aspects. He praised the greenery of the plant and said, when you enter into the plant you will feel like you are in a garden. He requested the management, to give priority to the tribal dominated people of villages like Biswali, Suniapada, Kuspada, Kannpur & Mania for providing more basic support to the land losers. Also he requested for providing employment to the local people in the upcoming project. He fully supported the proposed project.

8. Saikh Mustakim, Bhagatpur, Kanheipur:

He welcomed all the gatherings and informed that M/s. OCL has given them bread and butter and they all welcome the proposed project. He narrated the story of a King who was known for bringing smile in the face of dethroned people through peripheral development. Secondly

he narrated the CSR story of OCM (Odisha Cotton Mill). OCM used to show films of Amitav Bachan on Sunday as a CSR activity. When OCM was closed & OCL came and we thought OCL might also show films on Sunday as CSR activity. But OCL has been spending crores of rupees on CSR activity, such as piped water supply project, Madrasa/School development, construction of road, free medication to poor people, support to poor people in distress. They have extended their support at Bhagatpur muslim basti. He thanked OCL for providing Roti to the people of the periphery. He strongly supported the upcoming project.

9. Sri Prafulla Kumar Nayak, Ex-Sarapanch, Safa:

He addressed the chairpersons and the gatherings. He mentioned that they had already supported OCL 12 years back and since OCL is now expanding, so they must support the proposed project and asked that about 90% local people should get employment. After establishment of OCL, the people have got required Medical facility at their doorstep in this tribal dominated area. He again welcomed the proposed project also on behalf of Safa GP. He informed that the company have extended help for school and village developmental works.

10. Smt. Sasmita Sahoo, Sarapanch, Kanheipur GP:

She addressed all the chairpersons and gathering. She thanked OCL management at the outset for putting up water supply project at Kanheipur. She requested the management to provide a livelihood facility for the unemployed women of Kanheipur GP and take steps for providing facility to educate people for gaining employment opportunity and provide full support to the people. Finally she supported the project.

11. Sri Sukanta Samal, PS Member, Garudgaon:

He addressed all the august gathering and chairpersons on the dais. He mentioned that before establishment of OCL, there was no communication facility, people addressed us as *Junglee*, outside our area. But after establishment of OCL, our village looks like a town and Blswali is known everywhere. OCL has done various types of developmental works in the area. He thanked OCL management for the construction of Kanpur-Bhagatpur Road. He narrated that, such type of Road is not constructed anywhere in our area and will not be even in future. He requested OCL management to give employment to the unemployed local youths in the upcoming project. He mentioned that they have no environmental objection and he is supporting this proposed project.

12. Smt. Balema Bangera, Sarapanch, Karanji:

She welcomed all the chairperson and gathering. She supported the upcoming project and requested OCL management to include Karanji GP under the periphery development area (which was earlier in Safa GP).

13. Smt. Jyotirekha Nayak, Zilla Parisad Chairman, Cuttack:

She addressed all the gatherings and dignitaries. She expressed her pleasure on the various peripheral development works done by OCL in the surrounding GPs. She demanded for 90% employment of the local people in the proposed project. She requested for water supply

facility at Sapanpur village of Garudgaon GP and do the road works. She also requested OCL to give more emphasis on women empowerment in the locality and more employment to the local people. She supported the proposed expansion of the project.

14. Smt. Saraswati Priyadarshini Tiria, Suniapada:

She addressed all the gatherings and chairpersons. She mentioned that their village is her environment. She narrated that our village economic condition is now growing better than earlier after establishment of OCL. If OCL grows, we will grow. She supported the proposed expansion.

15. Smt. Bebina Sahoo, PS Member, Kotasahi:

She addressed all the dignitaries and chairpersons. She has requested for employment of the people of Kotasahi GP, Ambulance service to every household in the village on main road, streets and narrow roads inside villages and expansion of Tangi-Bhagatpur Road. She supported the proposed expansion.

16. Sri Mana Sinku, Ex. Sarapanch, Kanheipur, Badapukhari:

She addressed all the dignitaries and the gatherings. She supported the proposed expansion project. She requested OCL management to complete the on-going construction of the Bhagatpur-Kanpur Road at the earliest and provide water supply and other facility in their village.

17. Sri Nihar Ranjan Sahoo, Kanpur:

He fully supported the proposed expansion. He addressed all the chairpersons and people present at the meeting. He mentioned that OCL has done various developmental work in the periphery area. He requested the management to give employment of the unemployed local youths in the proposed project and do other peripheral works.

18. Sri Shakti Ranjan Routray, Kanpur:

He addressed all the dignitaries and people present from various GPs. He narrated that OCL is the one of the major source of periphery development of five surrounding GPs. He requested management to give employment to the local youths on priority basis and favoured the project.

19. Smt. Sujata Routray, Kanpur:

She informed that M/s. OCL has done various developmental works and providing drinking water. She expressed her happiness for the construction of much awaited Bhagatpur-Kanpur Road. She requested to give more emphasis on employment, health facilities, CSRm, plantation and education to the locals. She supported the proposed expansion.

20. Sri Rangadhar Behera, Kanpur:

He addressed all the dignitaries and people present in the meeting. He welcomed the proposed project in view of developmental activities of the local area. He narrated about the

greenery development, construction of road and community centre by M/s. OCL. He has requested to provide 24 hours medical facility with a doctor for the surrounding villagers.

21. Sri Bata Dehuri, Biswali:

He narrated the gathering and chairpersons that OCL has brightened the locality and requested the management to speed-up the development of Biswali village.

22. Smt. Jayashree Pradhan, Block Chiarman, Tangi-Choudwar:

She addressed all the dignitaries and the public at the gathering. She emphasized on employment of the local people and more developmental work in the area. She supported the future expansion and asked that the company management to take developmental works in consultation with them.

23. Sri Janmenjay Khillar, Mania:

He addressed the dignitaries and gathering. He requested to give more facility and employment for Uchhapada GP and as well as village Mania who have lost their land for the road and factory. He requested to give more focus on infrastructure of the government school, education sector such as opening of coaching center for creating talent students in the locality and medical facility to the poor people instead of making temples. At last he welcomed the future expansion and also for his villagers.

24. Dr. Sachidananda Pradhan, Principal, Biswanahakani Junior College:

He welcomed the proposed expansion. He narrated about the various developmental works done by OCL in Biswanahakani Junior College where the tribals students are studying. He narrated that OCL has provided water supply, toilets and other infrastructure, massive plantation in the college for which College has got various awards from the different Govt. and Non-Govt. bodies. He hoped that OCL will extend more helping hand for the development of Biswanahakani College and he will extend all supports and finally favoured the project.

25. Sri Choudhury Hemant Sahoo, Kanheipur:

He addressed the Chairperson and gathering present. He mentioned that OCL has been doing various developmental work since last 12 years. He supported the expansion in the view of development of the periphery area and favoured the project. He informed that there will be more pollution as they are expanding 2.5 times and they shall take pollution control measures. He requested to give priority on employment of the local Engineers and Management students and also to provided some type of financial support. He requested the OCL management to give emphasis on Pollution for proposed expansion and on poor people in all sectors for their development.

26. Sri Purna Chandra Behera, Kanpur:

He addressed all the dignitaries. He narrated that after establishment of OCL, the developmental initiative of the locality has been started since last 10 years and the area has economically developed after the local youth got employment. He narrated that "Sabka Sath

Sabka Bikas OCL". He praised for the construction of Kanpur-Bhagatpur Road by OCL at their cost. He requested to open a Engineering/ training institute for self-employment of the local youths, to engage local unemployed youths as Transporters for their self-employment. He requested for establishing a dairy farm and milk processing plant for the local farmers. He requested to give importance to the workmen for increasing their salary and to give focus on tailoring center for the womens. Lastly he supported the proposed expansion.

27. Sri Dhanantwary Routray, Kanpur:

He addressed all the Govt. dignitaries and gatherings and mentioned that OCL has done lot of developmental activities since its establishment. If OCL expands, the developmental activities of the locality will be increased. OCL has opened a Dispensary where local people are getting first-aid treatment. He requested for employment of the village youths in the proposed expansion project. He supported the project.

28. Sri Nibas Chandra Pandab, Safa:

He mentioned that OCL has done various developmental work since its establishment particularly in Safa. He requested to take up the construction of Saraswati Sishu Mandir at Safa which has not been initiated and should complete quickly. He requested to develop the Road from Chandanpur-Safa Medical for the betterment of tribal people. He requested to give self-employment linked trainings for skill development for the unemployed educated youths of Safa village who have been neglected. He supported the project.

29. Smt. Pana Tiria, Suniapada:

She has demanded to give her employment as project affected person as she has lost her land to the company. She informed that she earlier worked in the company and now she has been terminated and want employment in the same industry.

30. Sri Prasanna Kumar Behera, Mania :

He addressed all the dignitaries and informed that M/s. OCL has done many peripheral works like road, pond renovation work and electricity. He requested to give attention for the development of Mania Govt. School, to give emphasis for the development of Ketaki Jhara, Kayapali & Charigharia Tribal hamlets, to give lighting facility to the shopkeepers of near Hada Gate and development of the Kayapali Adivasi Primary School, Mania. He supported the proposed project.

31. Sri Amulya Kumar Sahoo, Sarapanch, Kotsahi:

He addressed all the dignitaries and gatherings. He narrated that initially he had objected for the construction of the project. Now he is fully supporting the project expansion, as OCL has done lots of developmental work in the periphery area and the economic development of the area due to such type of industrialization has increased. He requested OCL management to give more emphasis on environment, education, medical facility and to provide Ambulance for the poor tribal people.

32. Prasanta Sahoo, Mania:

He favoured the project and informed that the Company should fulfil all the commitments made by Sri Sahoo, Deputy Executive Director, KCMW. He said that all OCL has done massive CSR and periphery developmental works in the past in the periphery areas. He requested OCL to look after the local area development in future also and welcomed the proposed expansion project.

33. Sri Hemanta Kumar Khillar, Safa: He favoured the project and mentioned that all local people should get employment. He mentioned that OCL had done lots of development work in last 10 years and from last 4-5 years the relationship among the local people and the management is very good. However, no eye catching work has been done in Safa panchayat and requested to take care in future. He said that there is no drinking water facility at Suanri and Abhayapur of Safa GP, so he requested OCL management for provide drinking water facility for the two villages of Safa GP.

34. Sri Kailash Chandra Khillar, Mania: He favoured the project and informed that the Company should fulfill all the commitments made by Sri Sahoo, Deputy Executive Director, KCMW and all local people should get employment. He expressed his gratitude to OCL for the developmental works done in the periphery. He mentioned that agriculture, being the prime source of livelihood of people in the area, he requested OCL to arrange to construct Adibandh (embankments) on agriculture lands, so that the yield will increase and income of farmers will be increased. He fully supported the expansion project.

Sri Harish Chandra Nayak, Addl. District Magistrate, Cuttack asked the project proponent to present the commitments to the people on the demands raised by the public at the public hearing meeting.

Sri Manoranjan Sahoo, Deputy Executive Director, KCMW expressed his thanks and gratitude to the people for their whole-hearted support for the proposed project. He committed that, all the various demands raised by the people will be looked into and the development works of periphery area and surrounding regions will continue to be taken care of. He committed that all the development works of their and nearby Panchayat and surrounding regions will be taken care. He made some deliberation and made some commitments against the issues raised by the public like: (i) **Employment:** He assured that priority for employment will first be given to the local unemployed youths of their and nearby gram panchayat areas based upon their education and skills. He also informed that indirect employment of about 4000-5000 people can be generated by engaging the trucks of the local people for transportation; (ii) **Skill Development:** He informed that training will be given to the local boys and girls to develop their skills in different fields so that they get employment or become self-employed. A centre for skill development has already been started in Jajpur district and requested the senior representative of their panchayat to provide the name of the youths so that they can be trained. The company has also proposed to develop another skill development centre near factory in association with the Odisha Skill Development Authority, which is going to start its operation in next two months. A group of 100 youths can be given training over a period of 3-4 months in various fields so that they get employment or to become self-employed; (iii) **Agriculture:** He informed that they have already made a tie-up programme with NABARD for developing the unirrigated land of below 1 acres of the tribals in

Tangi-Choudwar area under Wadi Project, so that their household earning in agriculture sector can go upto Rs. 10,000.00 a year within a time period. He also informed that they will discuss with the local farmers with respect to construction of embankments (*Adibandha*) in lands to store rain water for the agriculture purpose so that the farmers can increase their livelihood; (iv) **Health Care:** He informed that they are already operating an Occupational Health Centre and they will take steps to upgrade the same with more facilities and (v) **Peripheral Development:** He informed that the company is associated with various peripheral development in the surrounding areas and committed that further peripheral developmental will be taken up with discussion with the local people. Lastly, he requested the villagers to extend their cooperation for smooth implementation of the proposed project.

Sri Sunil Kumar Gupta, Executive Director (Manufacturing, East), OCL India Limited thanked the public for their support and reaffirmed that the various commitments made by them will be taken care by the management.

Then Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant. The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English languages are annexed separately. Five (05) numbers of representation letters was also received in the meeting which is also annexed.




