

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 28.11.2018 (AT 11.00 AM) AT BHUYAN PADIA, AMIJAHARI, DIST. JAJPUR IN RESPECT OF M/S KAPILAS CEMENT MANUFACTURING WORKS (A UNIT OF OCL INDIA LIMITED) FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW CEMENT MILL OF CAPACITY 2.50 MTPA TO EXPAND THE EXISTING CEMENT GRINDING CAPACITY FROM 1.70 MTPA TO 4.20 MPTA IN VILLAGE BISWALI, PO: BARUNIA, DIST.: CUTTACK, ODISHA.**

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works (A Unit of OCL India Limited) for establishment of new cement mill of capacity 2.5 MTPA to expand the existing cement grinding capacity from 1.70 MTPA to 4.20 MTPA was held on scheduled date & time at Bhuyan Padia, Amiyajhari in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13<sup>th</sup> September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

**The Panel consisted of the following members:**

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the objective and guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works (A Unit of OCL India Limited).

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Sri Manoranjan Sahoo, Deputy Executive Director & Unit Head, M/s Kapilas Cement Manufacturing Works (A Unit of OCL India Limited) addressed the committee members and assembled public in Odia and told briefly about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control

measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other CSR activities being undertaken presently for the existing unit and the plans for the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

**1. Sri Prahallada Nanda, Chhatia, Jajpur:**

He welcomed all the dignitaries on the dais and the gathering and briefed about various developmental activities done by OCL, Viz: playground, water supply & street light in Paria GP, water supply & street light in Amiyajhari, , water supply & street light in Hadasahi. Byree Badapokhari renovation, Jagannath temple construction. Especially he thanked OCL for the remarkable job done in the Old Age Home, Sevakat Chhatia & Children home, Nation at Budhakendua. If the project expands then this area will be more developed, he expressed. He requested for up-gradation of existing dispensary and to convert it as 24 x 7 Medical facilities for the local people. Also he requested for another Ambulance, in addition to existing Ambulance as it is not covering 52 villages. He also urged OCL management for construction of rest-shed and toilet for the Lorry drivers. Lastly he thanked all and supports the proposed project.

**2. Sri Chitaranjan Samal, Mania:**

He welcomed the gathering and extended his support for the proposed Project. He expressed that Initial perception among the public that the Cement industry will make more pollution upto 10 Km radius in the area but practically after establishment of OCL, it is observed that there is no such type of pollution, due to adoption of various modern technology by the company for controlling the pollution. He gave example of the Township which is situated just 50 mtrs away from the plant where OCL staffs are staying with their family. He has given some examples of various Social developmental activities of OCL e.g. OCL provides Mobile Medical facilities for the Older people in the periphery area. He requested to the management for employment of 90% of the local people of both Cuttack & Jajpur district in the proposed project. All the benefits should be provided equally to both the districts. Lastly he fully supported the proposed project and requested the gatherings to extend full support.

**3. Sri Benudhar Biswal, Paria:**

He addressed the dignitaries and welcomed the gathering. He expressed that there is no additional land required for the proposed project. He narrated that OCL has already employed 60-70% local people and requested the management to extend it upto 90% in future project. He narrated that OCL maintained its pollution standard within the prescribed norms. He welcomed the proposed project and requested the management to follow proper recruitment procedure in the employment. He requested to give more emphasis on affected surrounding areas. He requested that CSR report should be shared with district administration of Jajpur.



**4. Sri Madhabananda Mohapatra, President, Sr. Citizen Forum, Solar:**

He addressed the dignitaries and the gatherings. He expressed that initially during the establishment of OCL, it was perceived that the Cement industry would create high pollution to the surrounding and deplete ground water, but practically it was not happened due to adoption of highly modern technology by the OCL management for the reduction of pollution. He supported the proposed project. He requested to give employment to the local people. He also requested the management to take up construction of the long pending demand of by-pass road from Solar to Chhatia to NH16, as heavy vehicles of OCL are plying through the solar village and any mishap can happen.

**5. Sri Nilamani Rout, Sarapanch, Solar:**

He addressed the dignitaries on the dais and the gatherings. He first supported the proposed Project. He expressed that our area development is in progress with the OCL's all time support. He requested the management for additional Ambulance service and 24 hrs medical facility and also requested the OCL management to construct bypass road from Solar-Chhatia-NH-16 immediately, avenue plantation on Byree to Barchana Canal Road and provide employment on the basis of qualification & skill instead of recommendation.

**6. Sri Manas Ranjan Panda, Paria:**

He addressed all the dignitaries and gatherings. He expressed that initially his perception was, Cement industry would be creating more dust pollution and our area would be covered with white dust. Already 10 years passed away and no such pollution is visible. OCL management has already made very good initiative to control the pollution and inside plant looks like a garden. He requested to adopt village Amiyajhari for its development. He emphasized OCL to look after the development of farmers and poor people. Employment should be in the right manner. He praised for extending helping hand by OCL management to the Children's Home "Nation" at Budhakendua and Oldage Home at Solar for its development. Lastly he fully supported the proposed Project.

**7. Smt. Bishnupriya Sahoo, Sarapanch, Byree:**

She addressed all the dignitaries and gatherings and supported the proposed Project. She mentioned that OCL is doing various developmental activities in their Panchayat. She requested OCL management for employment of the unemployed youths from Byree GP in the upcoming project.

**8. Smt. Swatika Panda, Sarapanch, Paria:**

She addressed all the dignitaries and welcomed all the villagers and requested OCL management to take steps for employment and development of the periphery villages. She supported the proposed project.

**9. Sri Mihir Prasad Das, Chhatia:**

He addressed all the dignitaries, press media, local representatives and villagers. He mentioned that during the initial phase they all protested for Cement plant in the area because of pollution and occupational diseases. But till date, no such



pollution or occupational disease are found in the area. There are no casualties till now like other industries in this area. OCL created lot of employment directly & indirectly. OCL has taken various steps to conserve water and to arrest depletion in ground water level and also doing lots of CSR activities much more than the laid down guidelines. He has requested to open permanent Medical for the local public and also provision for Vocational Skill Development Centers for the college going students at nearby colleges.

**10. Sri Sishir Kumar Biswal, Amiyajhari:**

He addressed all the dignitaries, local Panchayat representatives and gatherings. He supported the proposed Project. He expressed that if OCL expands, there is scope of more employment of the local people directly or indirectly. There has been no pollution since establishment of the industry. If the project will come more CSR activities will be undertaken in future. He cited an example of medical support for treatment of poor and tribal girl by OCL. He mentioned that OCL management stands beside each and every individuals like a family every time and spreads brotherly hood in the community. At last he requested the ADM for early grant of Environment clearance to OCL.

**11. Sri Bhagyadhar Mallik, Barchana Block Chairman, Chhatia:**

He welcomed all the dignitaries, and gatherings. He expressed that they are proud of industrialization and welcome the proposed Project of OCL. He shared some examples of financial support to poor villagers and also various developmental activities like health, education, livelihood and infrastructure support. Lastly he again supported the proposed Project and appealed the public to extend their whole hearted support for the upcoming 2<sup>nd</sup> unit, for which the development will be multiplied.

**12. Sri Dillip Kumar Praharaj, Solar:**

He welcomed all the dignitaries. He expressed that if the Company grows they will grow. He mentioned that the premises inside plant is very beautiful and requested the management for maximum engagement of local periphery panchayat trucks for transportation as compared to outside trucks.

**13. Sri Pradyumna Patra, Secretary, Nation, Budhakendua:**

He welcomed and addressed the dignitaries and gatherings. He fully supported the proposed Project. He praised for the various noble activities done by OCL management at the Children's Home 'Nation' for the orphan children. He shared that, the works done at NATION has been possible only because of the initiative of Smt. Kabita Sahoo. Lastly he again supported the proposed Project.

**14. Smt. Binodini Sahoo, ZillaParisad Member, Barchana, Zone 16, Darpan:**

She addressed all the dignitaries, Media persons, and gathering. She expressed that OCL has done various developmental work in 4 panchayats (Paria, Solar, Byree & Chhatia) such as Renovation of Harishankar Vidyamandir, toilet block of Harishankar Vidyamandir, developmental of Harishankar temple, construction of Road, Renovation of Pond, providing street light in the area and most importantly



they have taken much care of the little orphan children at 'Nation' to bring happiness in them. She strongly supported the proposed Project.

**15. Sri Bijay Kumar Nayak, Byree:**

He addressed all the dignitaries. He expressed that OCL has done various developmental works in Byree village like, construction of Jagannath temple, Mangala Temple, School, renovation of pond, etc. He requested the OCL management to give equal importance to both Jajpur & Cuttack district. Lastly he supported the proposed Project.

**16. Sri Sachidananda Samantaray, Chhatia:**

He addressed all the dignitaries, media persons and all the gathering. He expressed that along with agriculture, industrialization is needed in parallel for the development of the locality. He expressed his dissatisfaction towards employment of non-Odia people and he urged the OCL management for recruiting the qualifying Odia people among the land losers and project affected persons on the basis of qualification and skill. He welcomed the proposed Project.

**17. Sri Biranchi Narayan Swain, Byree:**

He addressed all the dignitaries, Media persons & the gatherings. He has expressed that zero pollution is not possible and OCL is maintaining pollution norms within the prescribed standard, so he supported the extension of OCL as he had supported earlier. OCL is doing various peripheral developmental work in the area. He requested the OCL Management to conduct public grievance meeting in the locality every week, if possible.

**18. Sri Mihir Bhanu Balverma, Amiyajhari:**

He expressed his gratitude to the chair person for being a participant of the public hearing to speak. He gave his heart felt support for the proposed Project.

**19. Sri Srikant Behera, PS Member, Amiyajhari:**

He welcomed the dignitaries, media persons and gathering. He welcomed the proposed Project. He requested for employment on the basis of qualification and merit without any biasness. He emphasized on developing health facilities, providing quality education for making good scholars and requested OCL management to open a coaching center at its cost.

**20. Sri Dambarudhar Rout, Solar:**

He addressed all the dignitaries, media persons, OCL management and the gatherings. OCL has undertaken various developmental activities for SSM, Byree like construction of Boundary wall, construction of class room, toilet block, and drinking water facility and also created awareness camp like blood donation camp in the school. Also provided medical and educational support to rural students. If the plant grows peripheral development will be inevitable. Lastly thanked OCL and supported the proposed Project.



**21. Sri Ashok Kumar Swain, Amiyahari:**

He supported the proposed project. He expressed that if OCL grows, the people will get employment. He requested OCL management to provide cement in subsidized rate to the poor people of the periphery villages for the construction of houses under Indira Awas Yojna, which will help the poor people to have a house.

**22. Sri Balaram Samal, Ex. Sarapanch, Byree**

He addressed all the dignitaries and the gatherings. He strongly supported the proposed Project. He mentioned that if OCL grows, people will get employment and their economic condition will be improved.


**23. Sri Sunil Sekhar Panda, Barunia:**

The meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.




