

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 09.11.2018 (10.00 AM) AT COMMUNITY CENTRE OF OMC, KALIAPANI FOR PROPOSED EXPANSION PROJECT OF SUKRANGI CHROMITE MINES OF M/S ODISHA MINING CORPORATION LIMITED FROM 1.30 LAKH TPA TO 3.0 LAKH TPA OF CHROMITE ORE OVER AN AREA OF 382.709 HA AT KALIAPANI IN SUKINDA TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT

The public hearing in respect of the proposed expansion project of Sukrangi Chromite Mines of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited, at Sukrangi, Tehsil: Sukinda was held on scheduled date & time in Sukinda Bhawan in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:



Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of expansion project proposed by M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited.

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Sri Bijay Kumar Behera, Regional Manager, Jajpur Region of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited addressed the



committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Sri Bharat Chandra Mahanta, Kaliapani

Welcoming the panel & gathering, he demanded priority in employment to local people of Ostapal, Kaliapani, Sukrangi Village. Further he asked M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited to take up peripheral development activity and give commitment in written for fulfillment of demands of the public. He requested the mines authority to open a permanent market complex near sukrangi mines. He supported the expansion project.

2. Sri Jagabandhu Mahanta, Kaliapani

Sri Mahanta expressed his support for the expansion project. He told that M/s OMC is taking step for environmental pollution control in the area and demanded to take more initiative to control dust pollution in the area. He reminded people that expansion his necessary for development of the area.

3. Sri Biswajit Mohanty, Ransol

He welcomed the panel & gathering and expressed his support for the expansion project. He demanded more plantation, employment and fulfillment of earlier commitments of the Company.

4. Smt. Bhagabati Mohanta, Chingudipal

Welcoming the panel and gathering, she demanded to fulfill the peripheral development work along with direct and indirect employment of local people. She told that OMC is carrying out development work in the local area. She urged people to take care of trees already planted and help local poor financially during advance health treatment cases. She supported the project.

5. Sri Rabindra Kumar Sahu, Saruabil

Sri Sahu welcomed the panel & gathering. He expressed his support for the expansion project. He requested M/s OMC to provide full financial assistance to the local High School build by them in the area. He expressed his concern on

runoff water from the mine being discharged to the nearby agricultural fields. He demanded M/s OMC to construct harvesting pond with canal facility to resolve the issue. He further requested employment and other development activity in the local area.

6. Saluka Hanhaga, Kaliapani

Expressing his support for the expansion project, He told that local area will be developed from the expansion project and further more people will get employment from the expansion project. Further OMC is always helping in local development activities i.e. Sports and cultural activities in the area.

7. Sri Ashok Pradhan, Kaliapani

He supported the project and requested to open a mini market in the area. He further requested M/s OMC to take up development in his Gram panchayat. He supported the project.

8. Sri Dasarathi Mahanta, Ostapal

He supported the project.

9. Sri Bijay Kumar Jena, Gurujanga

He supported the project.

10. Sri Nayak Bahadur, Birsanagar

He supported the expansion project and expressed his concern on no doctor in the medical facility in the local area. He demanded M/s OMC to fulfill the issue.

11. Sri Kalandi Ch. Barik, Gurujanga

He supported the project and asked M/s OMC to help the poor people for their day to day living.

12. Asish Kumar Jena, Kaliapani

Expressing his support for the expansion project, Sri Jena told that common people are not getting ambulance facility when required. He requested M/s OMC to ensure that ambulance facility is reaching to the common people of the area.

13. Sakila Hansda, Kaliapani

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal. He told that M/s OMC has taken up development activity in the area and requested for employment in the expansion project. He further requested M/s OMC to encourage sports activity in the local area.

14. Sri Gadadhar Dehuri, Sukrangi

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal and requested for employment of the local people.

15. Sri Prahallad Mahanta, Bhalukipahad

He told that company is not taking step for solving his issue and requested to solve his matter. He supported his support for the expansion project.

16. Sri Debadutta Mohanta, Ostapal

He welcomed the project and urged the company to give employment, supply drinking water at Koliposi Chhaka, repair the Bus stand and provide other facilities in the area.

17. Sri H. Mohanta, Kaliapani

Welcoming the project, Sri Mohanta requested M/s OMC to give training on Skill development to the local people for generation of employment opportunity in the area. He supported the expansion project of M/s OMC.

18. Sri Deepak Moharana, Kaliapani

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal and requested the project proponent to build a College at Kaliapani area.

19. Sri Dambarudhar Mohanta, Kaliapani

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he supported the project on behalf of his club and his village. He requested the corporation for more development activity, solving of unemployment issue through Skill development training in the area.

20. Jagat Pradhan, Saruabil

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal and urged the corporation to take adequate measures for control of pollution in the area. He demanded the corporation to stop discharge of waste water in the nearby agricultural fields and take step for control of fugitive dust generation during summer season. He expressed his concern on M/s OMC cutting trees for the present mining activity and not planting adequate trees. He requested M/s OMC for more plantations in the area.

21. Sri Sibusoren, Kaliapani

Welcoming the gathering, he requested the administration to take step for removal of unemployment issue in the area. He expressed his support for the expansion proposal.

22. Sri Raj Kumar Patra, Saruabil

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal and requested M/s OMC to take step to provide specialist doctors in the local hospital.

23. Sri Raj Kishore Mohanta, Ostapal

Expressing his support for the expansion proposal of M/s OMC, Sri Mohanta told that they are facing air pollution issue in the area and requested M/s OMC to take necessary step for air pollution control in the area.

24. Sri Ramesh Mohanta, Ostapal

He supported the expansion proposal of M/s OMC. He further requested the corporation for water sprinkling on roads and solving road traffic issue due to transporting vehicles from the mines.

25. Sri Sushant Pradhan, Saruabil

Sri Pradhan expressed his support for the project and demanded a market complex at Koliposhi Gram Panchayat and Facility Of drinking water and toilet facility for the drivers at parking yard.

26. Ms Sangita Pradhan, Kaliapani

She expressed her support for the expansion proposal of M/s OMC.

27. Sri Bharat Chandra Mohanta, Kaliapani

He welcomed the gathering and expressed his support for the project. He requested the corporation to provide street light facility on the electric poles from OMC gate to the Panchayat Office.

28. Sri Deepak Das, Sukrangi

He supported the expansion project.

29. Ms Rashmi Rekha Jena, Kankadapal

She expressed her support for the expansion proposal and requested M/s OMC to provide some training for development of local SHG groups.

30. Sri P. Pradhan, Kaliapani

He told that they are submitting they demands through written representation. He expressed his support for the project.

31. Ms Kalpana Jena, Kaliapani

She supported the expansion proposal of M/s OMC.

32. Rohit Kumar Mahanta, Kaliapani

He expressed his support for the project.

33. Ms Sabita Mahanta, Kankadpal

She supported the expansion project and demanded an Ambulance for her Gram Panchayat and quick action on fulfillment of earlier demands.

34. Ms Sulochana Sahoo, Birsanagar

She supported the expansion proposal of M/s OMC.

35. Ms Jinita Munda, Gurujanga

Welcoming the panel & gathering, she supported the expansion proposal and demanded water sprinkling on roads three times per day and steps for preservation of the planted trees by the Corporation.

36. Sri Santosh Parida, Kankadpal

He expressed his support for the expansion proposal. He told that plants are an important part of environment and demanded an herbal garden in the area. He further told that their area is filled with tribal people and requested to provide a club house and library, so that the poor people will get benefited.

37. Sri Saraj Kumar Mahanta, Bhalukipatana

He supported the expansion project and urged M/s OMC to fulfill all the demands raised by the public.

38. Sri Krutibas Bhanja, Kalarangitta

Welcoming the panel & gathering, he demanded to give preference in loading and transport to the local vehicles.

39. Sri Pravat Pradhan, Kankadpal

He welcomed the panel & gathering and told that environment will be affected by mining activity, so steps should be taken to prevent pollution. He told that M/s OMC has taken up many development activity in the area and hoped that they will take further steps for Pollution control. He expressed his concern on non existence of wild animals that were existing 20 years back due to mining activity. He demanded M/s OMC to help in improvement on life style of the local people by giving emphasis on education of local people. He requested M/s OMC to help the poor merit students in the form of financial aid in their education and help further in youth festival of local area. He demanded further

training to the candidates provided with skill development training for self employment. He insisted on need of a college in the area and development of the existing medical facility. Sri Pradhan further requested to provide lighting facility at the road connecting the township to the police station by LED bulbs. He reminded M/s OMC that the work progress of herbal garden is needed to speed up and finally requested the ADM and Regional officer to take necessary steps for development and pollution control in the area.

The Panel has received 2 nos. of written representations during the hearing which are enclosed herewith. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar asked the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Santanu Ratha, Director (Personnel) of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited made the commitment on issues raised by the public. The statement of issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant prepared in odia and English language and annexed separately. The meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.

ISSUES RAISED BY PUBLIC	COMMITMENT OF THE PROJECT PROPONENT
The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are as follows:	Sri Santanu Ratha, Director (Personnel) welcomed all the public and gathering on behalf of M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Limited. He thanked the public for supporting the expansion project and told that OMC is committed for fulfillment of demands of public and development of the local area. He committed to certain issues raised by the public are as follows:
1. Employment & Skill Development	Employment is connected with Industrial/Mine development. Skilled and qualified people are given preference in employment. People get indirect employment through contractors as per their recruitment policy. He assured that this time they will give both direct and indirect employment as per norms, policy and procedure. Keeping the vision of skill development of Central & State Government, OMC had conducted a mobilization programme. Around 30 people were trained in entrepreneurship programme for 2 weeks. In future OMC will further take step for self employment and vocational training programme.
2. Environment	For environmental pollution control OMC is taking up plantation activity in collaboration with the State Forest & Environment Department. Environment will be affected by the project. OMC has installed ETP inside the mine to treat the waste water generated inside the mine and further steps shall be taken for air pollution control. OMC will work with the expert to establish a Mini herbal park.



3. Education	<p>As a premiere PSU of the state Government, OMC is building model schools as per CBSE pattern and average 4 crore are being spent on each model school. OMC is actively involved in health development activity.</p> <p>Demand for a +2 College shall be fulfilled. After obtaining prior approval from the Principal Secretary (Education), infrastructure development work shall be commenced.</p> <p>OMC is taking utmost care to help the meritorious students. +2 SC students whose parents annual income is <6 Lakh/Annum is given a free residential coaching in Bhubaneswar. Some tribal students have been benefitted by the scheme to get into IITs.</p>
4. Health	<p>OMC is supplying medicine and other facilities to the medical and further step will be taken to bring specialist doctors to the local CHC.</p> <p>In the past OMC had collaborated with Rotary club and medical institutions to organize a eye camp which was a grand success where many people were benefitted.</p> <p>He further committed that OMC will take step for door step health check up and further help to locals during advance treatment outside the area.</p>
5. Other Development	<p>Area development is connected to industry/mine development. OMC is a premiere state PSU and also the largest mining PSU nationally. As per the Company norm 2% of average profit is spent for CSR activity. OMC is always committed for local development.</p> <p>OMC is interested to build a sports complex for the youth people in the area. Further, OMC is encouraging Football & Hokey in Odisha and already providing financial support for sports development in Odisha. OMC is ready to support any sports activity in the mines locality area.</p> <p>Fund has already been sanctioned on the commitment</p>



	<p>made during 2015 for establishment of model village at Kaliapani and Sukrangi.</p> <p>OMC had built some toilets in Chingudipal village 2 years back but was not successful due to lack of water supply and non awareness of the villagers on proper utilization of the facility.</p> <p>Finally Sri Ratha told that OMC want cooperation from the local public and all demands and expectations of people shall be fulfilled by CSR and peripheral development budget. He thanked the gathering for their support on the proposed expansion proposal. He hoped that M/s Odisha Mining Corporation will work out to fulfill the expectations of the local people.</p>
