

PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION (HEARING) OF KALTA IRON ORE MINES OF M/S STEEL AUTHORITY OF INDIA LTD. FOR PROPOSED PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 49,701 TPA IRON ORE OVER ML AREA OF 25.981 Ha AT KALTA VILLAGE UNDER KOIRA TAHASIL OF SUNDARGARH DISTRICT (ODISHA).

Public consultation (hearing) of Kalta Iron Ore Mine of M/s Steel Authority of India Ltd. was held on 15-09-2021 (11 pm) at Football Play Ground beside Gram Panchayat Office of Kalta village under Koida Block of Sundargarh district in the state of Odisha for their application relating environmental clearance on proposed Kalta Iron Ore Mines. Addl. District Magistrate (ADM), Sundargarh presided over the consultation (hearing) meeting. In the beginning, the Regional Officer, Rourkela of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha and ADM explained the villagers on the aspects of consultation (hearing) for environmental clearance under E. I. A. Notification, 2006 and invited Kalta Iron Ore Mine of M/s Steel Authority of India Ltd. to address public on details of the expansion project of the existing Iron ore mine and its environmental aspects for their views onward. Sri Prasanná Kumār 'Kartā', ଉପାଧ୍ୟକ୍ଷକ, Kalta Iron Ore Mine of M/s Steel Authority of India Ltd. addressed public on the expansion project and its environmental aspects. ADM then invited the public to address their views on environmental aspects of the project. 33 nos. of villagers opined their views as mentioned below. Attendance sheets of villagers present & signed and who addressed views are annexed in Annexure – 1 & 2 respectively.

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

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
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
