Sri Surya Narayan Dash, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Subarnapur presided over the meeting along with Er. Ramesh Kumar Ekka, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Sambalpur.

At the outset, Er. Ramesh Kumar Ekka, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur welcomed all the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF & CC), Government of India. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing meeting of the project proposed by M/s. Dubula Stone Quarry, At-Dubula Village of Subarnapur district on 03.09.2021 At: 09.00 A.M. At: Dubula Village, Tarbha Tahasil of Subarnapur district was duly advertised in Odia daily "*The Prameya*", dtd. 30.07.2021 and English daily "*New Indian Express*" dtd.30.07.2021.07.2021(Paper clipping are enclosed as Annexure-I).

The Addl. District Magistrate has also briefed about the proposed project and requested the public who were present during the public hearing meeting to express their opinions and views on the proposed project. He also requested the representative of the proposed project to highlight about their proposed project before the public.

The Representative from the side of successful bidder of quarry Sri Narottam Mohanty addressed the public during the meeting. He briefly explained about the project and assured the public that the company will adopt latest technology to prevent any pollution and implement good CSR practices for the welfare of the local area.

About 50-60 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and out of them 46 participants have put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as Annexure-II. 15 persons have registered their name to deliver their views during public hearing and list is annexed as Annexure-III.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing meeting is as follow;

Sl. No.	Name of the Participants and their deliberation on the proposed project.
1.	<u>Sri Jitendra Sa, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project and stated that the proposed project will be adversely impact on nearby paddy field and villages.
2.	<u>Sri Braj Nag, Baghia:</u> He informed that at least 200 families are living nearby the proposed site and if mining activities will be carried out, then they will mostly be affected. Therefore, he opposed the proposed project.
3.	<u>Sri Sachida Mahanand, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project and stated that if the Government will rehabilitate them at another suitable location, then he can support the project.
4.	<u>Sri Rohit Majhi, Dubula:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He said that no proper survey have been made in the area. People are living on the proposed site. Also no development work is being carried out by the Govt. in that area. Due to mining activities, there will be deforestation in this area, which will affect their area.
5.	<u>Sri Bidyabushan Kheti:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He said that due to mining activities there will be deforestation in this area, which will affect the local villages. The Forest and Gochar land will be destroyed due to operation of the mine.
6.	<u>Sri Surendra Kahnar, Dubula:</u> He opposed the proposed project.
7.	<u>Sri Arabindo Sahu, Dubula:</u> He expressed that due to blasting activities of the mine their houses will be damaged which is experienced from another quarry. The local villagers may be affected by environmental pollution. He is not in favour of the project.
8.	<u>Sri Daktar Mohananda, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project. They are living within 200 mtrs from the

	proposed site and due to blasting their house will be damaged.
9.	<u>Sri Nilambar Sahu, Tarbha:</u> He expressed his views that the public hearing is not widely publicized and most of the villagers unknown about the public hearing meeting. The nearby villages will face problems due to mining activities. Finally, stated that he is not in favour of the proposed mining project.
10.	<u>Sri Jita Mahananda, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He told that at least 200 families are living nearby the proposed site and if mining activities will be carried out then they will be worst affected.
11.	<u>Sri Ramesh Sahu, Surjyamunda:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He stated that, by operating the mine, the agricultural land will be affected and the environment will be polluted. He said that as they are completely dependent on agriculture the villagers do not want the operation of the mine. He is not in favour of the environmental clearance of the mine.
12.	<u>Sri Prasant Sa, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project. The local villagers may be affected due to environmental pollution and hence they are against the proposed mining project.
13.	<u>Sri Chintamani Kuanar, Dubula:</u> He expressed his views that villages and agriculture field will be badly affected due to mining activities. He is not in favour of the mine.
14.	<u>Sri Aswini Bisi, Purunapani:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He expressed that due to operation of the mine the villagers of this area will face problems. The local villagers may be affected by diseases due to environmental pollution. He said that their buildings will be badly damaged due to blasting activities in the mine.
15.	<u>Sri Antariyami Mallik, Baghia:</u> He opposed the proposed project. He informed that local villagers are mostly depend on that proposed mining area for their day today livelihood and if permission will be given and mining project will be made operational then it will hamper their livelihood.

During public hearing meeting about 06 nos. of written statement have been received from the participants is enclosed as **Annexure-IV**
