

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING FOR SARUABIL CHROMITE BLOCK HELD ON 23.12.2021 (11.00 AM) AT SARUABIL FOOTBALL GROUND, SARUABIL IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR FOR PRODUCTION OF 1.00 MTPA CHROMITE ORE (ROM) WITH MAXIMUM EXCAVATION OF 6.48 MILLION CUM PER ANNUM THROUGH OPENCAST MINING OVER ML AREA OF 246.858 HA AT VILLAGE SARUABIL, KAMARDA AND TAILANGI UNDER SUKINDA TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT OF M/s. TATA STEEL MINING LIMITED (FORMERLY M/s. T.S. ALLOYS LTD.)

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s. Tata Steel Mining Limited for production of 1.00 MTPA chromite ore (rom) with maximum excavation of 6.48 million cum per annum through opencast mining over ML area of 246.858 ha was held on scheduled date & time in Saruabil Football Ground in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13th September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

The Panel consisted of the following members:

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Tata Steel Mining Limited.



Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Dibyendu Behera, Asst. Divisional Manager of M/s. Tata Steel Mining Limited addressed the committee members and assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. **Bharat ChMahanta, Kaliapani**
He welcomed the panel and expressed her full support for the public hearing. He requested TSML to develop green belt in surrounding villages & he also told that as there was no proposal of rehabilitation of people due to expansion so he fully support the project.
2. **BhagabatiMohanta, Chingudipal**
She welcomed to the administration, local gathering & media. She told that environment will be degraded due to mining project & human will not exist without good environment. He suggested for more sustainable environment by making more green belt development. She hopes for more sustainable environment. She fully support the project as their daily livelihood depends on the mine. She requested TSML to give direct and indirect employment and other business opportunity to the local people. She suggested for making kansapanchayat more developed & supports the public hearing.
3. **Birbal Das, Kamarda**
Hetold that nearby villagers are attending the public hearing and they were not aware about the process of public hearing. He asked to District administration that whether any rehabilitation of local people will be done or not. They are getting more benefit from the earlier lessee such as school, medical, marketing, Bus communication but till now no such arrangement has

been provided by TSML. He requested TSML management to discuss about the employment to local youth & women & developmental work at their panchayat & villages. He supports the public hearing.

4. **Biswajit Mohanty, Sarpnach, Ransol G.P**

He welcomed the panel & gatherings He told that if TSML will produce 1 Million Ton then employment problem will be solved and development of local villages will be done. He fully supports the proposed expansion.

5. **Krutibas Bhanja, Ransol**

He welcomed the panel & gatherings He fully supports the public hearing but they have some issues & problem such as communication facility to school, bus facility for labors & college Bus facility.

6. **Geetanjali Mohanata, bhimtangar**

She told that last fifty years Tata steel mining activity was going there and become Asia's largest producing industry and now they have started second phase. From report she told that chromium was found in the body 26 lakhs people and as per 2007 Blacksmith report, Sukinda is one of the polluted area among top 10 polluted cities. Govt has allocated mining lease for fifty years to Tata steel but local residents were not getting a small land patta, so that they are not getting residence and caste certificate for which students were not getting stipend for education. 75 numbers of villages will be affected because of mining of chrome as polluted water will be discharged directly to Damsala River. People are suffering from many deases such as Jakhma, Kidney & ENT because of pollution. She told that people who are losing their land should be rehabilitated according to Govt procedure. She supports the mining activity subjected to proper follow up of Govt guideline by Tata steel.

7. **Dhirendra Dehuri, Saruabil**

He told that govt guideline regarding mining activity should be public domain. He told that since last one year agricultural development work has been done and he is happy about the educational training provided through ASPIRE in Kansa Gram Panchayat. He told that tribal people who were affected by losing their land should be get benefitted by providing them employment opportunity. In this regard allegation has been given to Tata steel. They welcomed the expansion as more employment opportunity will be created and more training activity will be done if production will be more.

8. **Netrananda Mohanta, Kamarda**

He told that if expansion of mine will be done then environmental pollution will occur and nearby villagers of local kamarda, Tialangi & Sarubil villages will be affected. He told that employment was not given till date to local villagers of Kansa Gram Panchayat & also to the the earlier villagers who were working at



B.C Mohanty Mines & Saruabil Mines. Mining activity has been started since one year but no employment was given till date by Tata management to the earlier regular employee as well as who were working in CIPL on contract basis. They have well qualified but they were not getting employment opportunity. In the near past they have approached local Tahasildar regarding unemployed local youth, employment of loading labors. Thousands of labors are not getting employed till date. They wanted expansion but prior to expansion employment should be given to local youth; green belt development should be created. No practical implementation of commitment has been done since last one year. Local ordinary people will not get benefited because of expansion. He fully opposed the proposed mining expansion. He told that committee should be formed to acknowledge problem by door to door survey. They want practical employment. Tata steel management has denied the women employment. At last he fully opposed the public hearing.

9. **KeshabchHesha, Kalarangita.**

He told that environmental protection should be provided in the mining area. Steps should be taken by TSML for environment protection in local villages as environment will be degraded due to expansion. He supports the project.

10. **Sanjay Ku Parida, Kankadapal.**

He emphasized on how environment will be healthy and green belt must for healthy environment. He suggested for plantation of fruit bearing trees and local medicinal species trees such as kendu, harida etc. water will be polluted because of mining activity so he suggested for mega ETP for treatment of water and make it reusable. He supports the public hearing.

11. **JagabandhuMohanta, Kalarangiata.**

He welcomed the panel & gives his full supports for the proposed expansion of Tata steel with certain conditions. He requested for development of local women through SAG group. He requested for two times fulfillment of environmental degradation. He requested to give Education, health, communication, employment facility to kansa Gram panchayat. He also told that special care should be given for sustainability of local peripheral environment.

12. **HiralalMohanta, Kalarangiata**

He fully supported the expansion. Employment and health facility should be provided by TSML.


13. **Rabindra Ku Sahoo, Sarapanch, Kansa G.P**


