

**Proceeding of the public hearing conducted on 20.04.2022 for Jaipur & Nuapada Mahanadi Patha Cluster Sand Quarry, Tahasil- Raghunathpur in the district of Jagatsinghpur, Odisha**

---

A public hearing was held on 20.04.2022 at 10.30 AM at PWD I.B.-cum- Rest shed, Jaipur of Jagatsinghpur district for the above proposed cluster sand quarry (16.16 Ha). Smt. Chinmayee Biswal, Additional District Magistrate, Jagatsinghpur presided over the meeting. Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradeep assisted during the public hearing. She welcomed the public, who were present at the venue for participating in the hearing. Attendance sheets of the officials present in the hearing and that of public present inside the venue are annexed as **Annexure- I and II** respectively. About 70 to 75 persons were present in the meeting, out of which only 19 number of persons put their signature in the attendance sheet and others refused to put their signature. 08 persons intended to deliver their views and their list is annexed as Annexure-III.

Earlier, public hearing of this cluster sand quarry was scheduled to be held on 22.09.2021, which could not be completed as per procedure due to public agitations. Subsequently another date was fixed on 07.01.2022, which was cancelled by district administration apprehending agitations again. This was the third trial for conducting the public hearing and some people of village Jaipur entered into the site with placards mentioning to stop sand mining and allied dialogues. Most of those people though present inside the public hearing site refused to disclose their identity and did not put their signature in the attendance sheet. During last six months, 04 no.s of written statements were received from inhabitants of Jaipur village to cancel Jaipur Sand quarry. 02 no.s of written statements were received during the public hearing. All such statements are attached with Annexure-III. Video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing was done and it will be forwarded to State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Government of Odisha as such along with this proceeding.

At the outset, Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14<sup>th</sup> September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India and its amendment No. S.O. 141 (E)

of Dt.15.01.2016 and the importance of the actual views of local public regarding the project. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting this public hearing was duly advertised in one Odia daily newspaper; Dharitri; dtd. 18.03.2022 and in one English daily newspaper, The New Indian Express dtd.18.03.2022 following due procedure for intimation of public. Further, the same information was also propagated through notices displayed at various places in the area including concerned gram panchayat offices. Copies of EIA report were displayed at the office of the Tahasildar, Raghunathpur and gram panchayat offices of Chhapada ( For Jaipur) & Bidyadharpur ( For Nuapada) G.P. Executive summary of the proposed project both in Odia & English was also displayed at the meeting venue for ready reference of public. The executive summary was also made available in the website of State pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar ([www.ospcbboard.org](http://www.ospcbboard.org)).

ADM, Jagatsinghpur and Regional Officer, Paradeep explained briefly that Jaipur sand quarry and Nuapara sand quarry are two separate sand quarries on Mahanadi river. As both the quarries are within 500 m from each other and treated as a cluster of sand quarries as per the provisions of law, a common environment clearance (EC) has been applied for Jaipur- Nuapada Cluster sand quarry. They requested public to place their views about the environmental impacts of the proposed sand quarries and emphasized that their statements should be related to environmental pollution and its control aspects. Then the Regional Officer requested Miss Rupalika Dash, Tahasildar, Raghunathpur to describe before the public about the details of the project and its impact on surrounding environment.

Miss Rupalika Dash, Tahasildar, Raghunathpur presented and briefed about the importance of sand mining in construction sector and how the same contributes towards nation building. She highlighted about the details of the two sand mines having a total area of 16.16 Ha in Jaipur and Nuapada village of Jagatsinghpur district. Mining plan has been prepared and approved. Auctioning of both the sand quarries have been over and highest bidders have been selected. Sand mining capacity from the cluster will be 51000 m<sup>3</sup>/year (Jaipur- 31000 m<sup>3</sup>/year in 9.46 Ha, Nuapada 20000 m<sup>3</sup>/year in 6.697 Ha.) as per the approved mining plan. As per the provisions of OMMC Rules, 2016, sand mines need environmental clearance and for that purpose application for public hearing was filed. On behalf of the highest bidder, Sri Saidutta Das described that baseline study has


been carried out and EIA report has been prepared accordingly. All required pollution control measures will be taken as per the environment management plan. Mining will be done by manual method while transportation will be done by smaller vehicles so as to protect the roads. Plantation will be done on the river bank to protect the river bank and no tree will be cut in the surrounding area. Monitoring of air and water will be done in the area and steps will be taken if required to maintain their quality.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Paradeep then invited public for their deliberations. Details of deliberations are annexed at **Annexure-IV**.

After the deliberations by the public was over, Regional Officer, SPCB, Paradeep summarized various issues raised by the public and invited the authorized representative of the highest bidder of the proposed sand mine to offer his views on those issues. On behalf of the highest bidder, Sri Saidutta Das placed his views on the issues raised by the public.

The summary of the views and concerns of the public and the commitments made by the representative highest bidder are annexed in Oriya language & English language as **Annexure-V & VI** respectively.

Finally the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and other participants.

**Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing conducted on 20.04.2022 for Jaipur & Nuapada Mahanadi Patha Cluster Sand Quarry, Tahasil- Raghunathpur in the district of Jagatsinghpur**

1. Laxmipriya Mohanty, Naugaon, Jagatsinghpur

She challenged the public hearing process and opined that public hearing should be conducted in each village of the affected area so as to take opinion of larger section of people. She also stated that common people do not get any information about the technical details of river flow and sand mining. Sand mining will cause environmental damage and so this public hearing should be cancelled.

2. Dilip Jena, Jaipur

He supported the project and mentioned that the Jaipur sand quarry is operating since 1980's and local villagers were employed due to the mining operation. He demanded the sand mines to be operated by employing local villagers as done previously.

3. SahedaTabsum, Sarpanch, Bidyadharapur G.P.

She intimated that Jaipur sand quarry may be getting opposition from people, but Nuapada sand quarry should be separated from it and people in general are in its support. She mentioned that local villagers of Bidyadharapur have been getting employment in the mining operation and operation of mines should be done. She also mentioned that Nuapada people will get benefitted from operation of Nuapada sand quarry.

4. Pitambar Das, Jaipur

He welcomed the project stating that lifting of sand from the river and its transport will not cause any damage to road as the same has been carried out for last 30 years. Rather, non-operation of the sand mines for last two years has affected livelihood of local people. Further unavailability of sand locally has resulted in increased cost. He requested for operation of the sand cluster and all should agree for it.

5. Smruti Ranjan Mohapatra, Jaipur

He anticipated environmental threats such as change of river course, effect on village roads, loss of agriculture and air pollution due to transportation. So he opposed the sand mining at Jaipur sand quarry and demanded to cancel the public hearing.

6. Abhaya Parida, Khandatari

He welcomed the project stating that there will not be any damage caused to the environment and river bridge due to mining operation.


7. Manas Ranjan Das, Jaipur

He opposed the mining project at Jaipur sand quarry and stated that lifting of sand and thereby its spillage will cause damage to agriculture lands and accident in roads. Mining activity will affect the bridge to be constructed and river bank/embankment resulting in intrusion of flood water into the villages during flood. He requested to cancel the sand mining lease of Jaipur Sand quarry.

8. Debi Prasad Tripathy

He supported the project and stated that local villagers will be engaged in the mining activity. He intimated that water sprinkling on the roads will prevent air pollution.



**Points raised by the public during public hearing conducted on 20.04.2022 for Jaipur & Nuapada Mahanadi Patha Cluster Sand Quarry, Tahasil- Raghunathpur in the district of Jagatsinghpur**

**The public raised the following issues and apprehensions for redressal by the project proponent.**

1. To prevent transportation activity through heavy vehicles to prevent damage of village roads and accident due to traffic congestion
2. To protect of river embankment and river bank by plantation
3. To engage only local villagers in mining and transportation
4. To prevent spillage of sand on roads and to do adequate water sprinkling
5. To protect agriculture land from air borne sand dust during transportation.

**Views of Project Proponent on the issues raised by the public during the Public hearing.**

Sri Saidatta Das, on behalf of the highest bidder addressed the issues raised by public and committed that

1. Transportation of sand will be done by lighter vehicles like tractor and tippers only
2. Plantation will be done at the river bank every year
3. Local people will be engaged for sand mining in both the quarries
4. Road cleaning will be done on daily basis on the transport roads and water sprinkling will be done by water tankers
5. Care will be taken to prevent air pollution during transportation and air borne sand to agricultural land.

The same public hearing is now rescheduled to be held on 20-04-2022 at 10.30 A.M. at PWD IB-cum-Rest Shed, Jaipur in Jagatsinghpur District.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:
