Particulars of Organization, Functions & Duties

[Section-4 (1) (b) (i)]

The State Prevention and Control of Pollution Board (SPCB), Odisha was constituted in pursuance to subsection (1) of Section- 4 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1974, vide Notification No.1481-VII-HI-11/83 (Vol. II)-S.T.E., dated 15.07.1983 after the Odisha Legislative Assembly adopted the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. The Board was re-designated as State Pollution Control Board, Odisha vide Notification No. Env-E(F)/8/99/1882 F&E, dated 16.07.1999 of the Forest and Environment Department, Govt. of Odisha.

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD

The constitution and functions of the Board are clearly spelt out in the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. The Board is entrusted with the responsibility of implementation of Environmental Laws, particularly the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and a number of Rules and Notifications issued thereunder as amended from time to time.

Duties of the Board, however, can broadly be classified into the following four main categories:

1. To plan a comprehensive programme for prevention, control or abatement of pollution and enforce the environmental laws
2. To advise the State Government on any matter concerning prevention and control of water and air pollution
3. To conduct Environmental Monitoring and Research
4. To create public awareness
