

Terms of Reference:

1. The Technical Committee shall examine the applications and reports regarding “No increase in pollution load” for changes in plant configuration and product mix.

2. The Technical Committee after proper appraisal of the application shall submit its report along with recommendation to the SPC Board for consideration of certificate regarding " No increase in pollution load" as required under MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Notification No. SO-3518(E) dt.23.11.2016.
3. The Members nominated by F&E Department will be paid sitting fees of ₹ 3,000/- per day for attending the meeting.
4. The Members nominated by F&E Department during their stay at Bhubaneswar, will be paid ₹ 4,000/- per day towards their Boarding, lodging and local transport expenses.
5. The Members nominated by F&E Department are eligible to reimburse actual travelling expenses on production of tickets and also get DA as per rule. Those who travel by Taxi will be paid on production of bills or as per the rate approved by Govt. in Tourism Deptt. whichever is less.
6. In case if it is decided to have a site visit before making recommendation, the members nominated by F&E Department will be paid travel expenses including D.A. as per rule. SPC Board shall arrange local conveyance, accommodation including fooding. Further they will be paid a sum of ₹ 1000/- as a part of sitting fee for technical inspection/evaluation of the site.
7. Member Convenor shall ensure the copy of the information is made available to all the members sufficiently in advance.
8. The Technical Committee shall make recommendation based on the deliberation.
