PUBLIC NOTICE

KIND ATTENTION: ALL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES (HCFs) AND COMMON BIOMEDICAL WASTE TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL FACILITY (CBWTDF)

Attention of all Occupier of Health Care Facilities (HCFs) & Common Biomedical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facilities (CBWTDFs) in the State of Odisha is drawn to the provisions of the Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 on the issue of implementation of Bar-Code and Global Positioning System in Heal Care Facilities and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facilities. The rule 4 (i) stipulates that Bar-Code System for bags or containers to be sent out of premises of HCFs for any purpose shall be established within one year from the date of notification of the rules. Similarly, Rule 5(c) refers to implementation of Bar-Code and Global Positioning System in Common Facility in accordance with the guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi within the above stipulated time. The major objectives of establishment of the system in both HCFs & CBMWTDFs are as follows;

- (i) to track BMW from the source of generation to the destination for final treatment & disposal,
- (ii) to prevent pilferage of waste during transportation,
- (iii) to make real time online monitoring of waste generation, collection, treatment & disposal etc.


Hence, all HCFs utilizing the services Common Facilities [M/s. Sani Clean Pvt. Limited, Tangiapada, Khorda, (ii) SCB Medical College & Hospital, Cuttack, (iii) Rourkela Government Hospital, (iv) VIMSAR, Burla] for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of biomedical wastes are directed through this notice to ensure establishment of Bar-Code System by end of September, 2019. Similarly, the Operators of the Common Treatment and Disposal Facility are directed to implement the bar code and global positioning system by end of September, 2019.

It may be noted that failure to comply with the above shall amount to violation of the provisions of the rules and may lead to revocation of authorization order and/or levying of environmental compensation, as per this order of Hon'ble NGT dt. 15.07.2019, in O.A No- 710/2017, 711/2017, 712/2017 & 713/2017.






